FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS

Someone flipped their car on State Route 373 & someone flipped their guad and bumped their head out at the sand dunes. That sounds like news, but its not news at all to us, that kind-a thing happens all the time and the fire department gets called out. The real news is that we had four new people show up at our last monthly meeting. Its seems that we are finally getting through to people that you don't have to be young & strong to be on the fire department. I've been saying all along that you don't need endurance & stamina to do most of what we do on the fire department. Only once or twice a year does one of us need to drag a hose up to a burning building & squirt water through a window & we have a few young people for that. There are dozens of easier activities at a fire or a car wreck that anyone can do. Then there are dozens more things that need done at the station. I've been distributing a list to people so that they can see how many ways there are that they could help. I can't call them old people because they are my friends, but we had four of my friends who saw this list & saw that they could help, decide to come to the last meeting. Ya, lets not call them old people, lets just say that they aren't going to want to drag a charged two an a half inch hose accross the street, but they are convinced now that they can help the fire crew on a call-out or at the station & they want to help. Another bit of news is that the VFD has chosen another date for an open house / barbeque. April 26th we will be inviting specifically our Ambulance friends, Beatty fire, Pahrump fire, Shoshone fire, Radio club, Medivac helicopter crews, Town Board members, etc. but it would be a great time for anybody to drop by & see who we are, what equipment we have & what we need help with.
