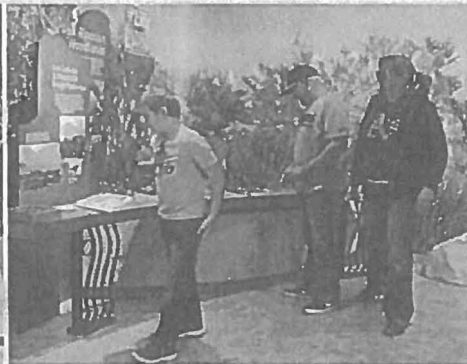

We've been talking to some dairy hands that are thinking that they maybe want to become fire fighters . Several of us have gone to Pahrump on several weekends for training offered at both the county fire station & the town fire station . Then the Mercy Air Medi-Vac crew brought their helicopter over to our fire station to do some safety training with us . Also we did a little bit of fire safety training for the middle school . So Its been a kind-a big training month for us .

Then we had a fire here in the valley . It was in the middle of the night , so most of you wouldn't have seen it & in the middle of the night we generally won't run our sirens , so you wouldn't even hear us taking our trucks to the fire . It was big enough that we asked for some help from the county fire guys in Pahrump . They sent over two trucks & six guys and we kept them here for almost four hours .

Our next monthly meeting will be @ 7 PM March 5 . We expect to have the two guys that started coming to our meetings in January to join us then & we can start using them on fire call - outs . The meeting is open to the public so anyone can just show - up . You can meet the guys & we'll show you around the station .

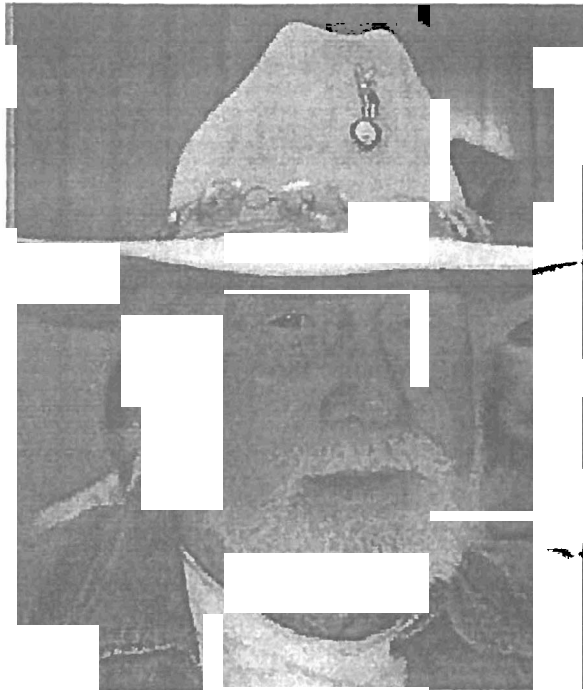



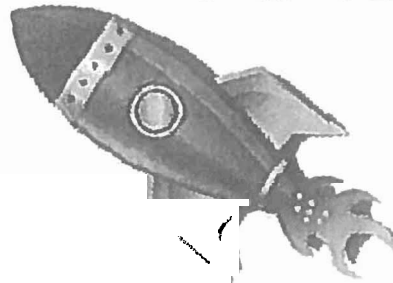
