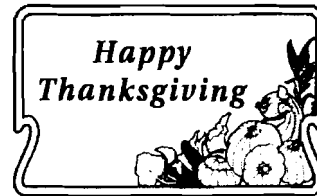

FIRE DEPARTMENT

The fire department has some news from the month of October . We had a big fire to respond to on 12 October . You didn't see a lot of smoke , because the fire was in Shoshone .

We call it " mutual aid " . Beatty will go to Goldfield or Amargosa or into the park , Pahrump will go to Spring Mountain Pass or Sandy Valley , Crystal or Amargosa , Mercury will go to Pahrump or Crystal or Amargosa , Shoshone will go to the park or Pahrump or Amargosa , and we will go to Beatty or the park or Pahrump or Shoshone . We do this only when called (invited) through the sheriff's dispatch (911 call center) and we don't send a bill . This month we sent six guys , two tenders (tankers) and an engine to Shoshone .

That sunday afternoon , Shoshone had two unocupied homes & one out building burn to the ground . The clinic, museum , resteraunt/bar and other structures were threatened by the fire , but Shoshone & Amargosa engines contained the fire to the west and we were fortunate that the wind took the fire mostly out into the brush in the flood plane east of town . Pahrump Valley Fire Rescue was there , Nye County Emergency services was there , San Bernadino County fire was there , BLM & Forest Service fire crews were there . Lots of fire , lots of people , lots of trucks , lots of work , lots of lights & sirens .

And there was some danger & excitement : Important buildings could easily have been lost except for the speedy reactions of Shoshone fire & neighboring fire departments , some power poles burnt & fell before the power was shut off . Two highways were closed for a while . Amargosa was asked to stay late into the night & BLM fire crews had to come back for two more days before the fire was declaired " out "

We are an all volunteer fire department & we need more volunteers . For some excitement & an opportunity to serve your community , give some thought to joining the Amargosa VFD (ages 14 to 90 or 100 accepted , ladies are engouaged to join , we will train you) .

Remember the old adage, you are what you eat? Make it your motto. When you choose a variety of colorful fruits and veggies, whole grains, and lean proteins, you'll feel vibrant and healthy, inside and out.

Live longer and stronger - Good nutrition keeps muscles, bones, organs, and other body parts strong for the long haul. Eating vitamin-rich food boosts immunity and fights illness-causing toxins. A proper diet reduces the risk of heart disease, stroke, high blood pressure, type-2 diabetes, bone loss, cancer, and anemia. Also, eating sensibly means consuming fewer calories and more nutrient-dense foods, keeping weight in check.

Sharpen the mind - Key nutrients are essential for the brain to do its job. People who eat a selection of brightly colored fruit, leafy veggies, and fish and nuts packed with omega-3 fatty acids, can improve focus and decrease their risk of Alzheimer's disease.

Feel better - Wholesome meals give you more energy and help you look better, resulting in a self-esteem boost. It's all connected—when your body feels good you feel happier inside and out.

Of course, balanced nutrition is more than calorie counting. There are many other aspects to creating a nutritious lifestyle.

How many calories do adults over 50 need?

Use the following as a guideline:

A woman over 50 who is:

Not physically active needs about 1600 calories a day Somewhat physically active needs about 1800 calories a day Very active needs about 2000 calories a day

A man over 50 who is:

Not physically active needs about 2000 calories a day Somewhat physically active needs about 2200-2400 calories a day Very active needs about 2400-2800 calories a day

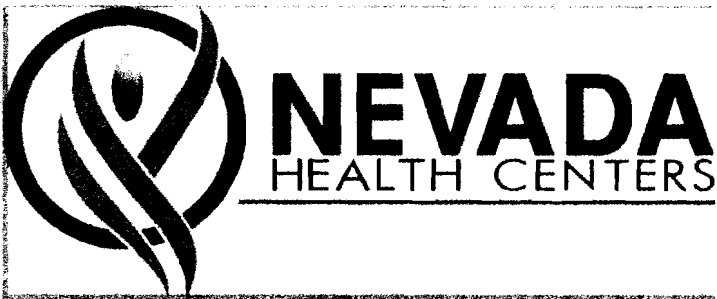

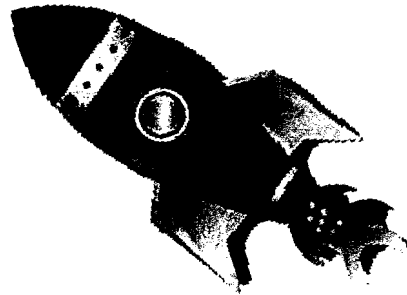
