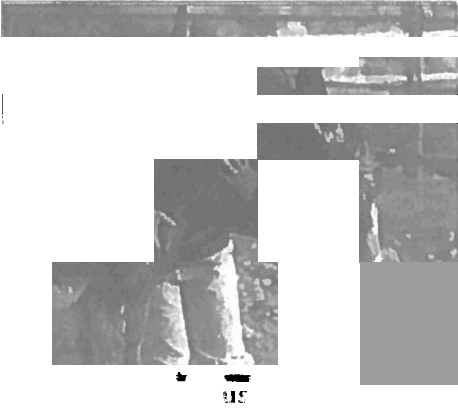


Wild Burro Rescue

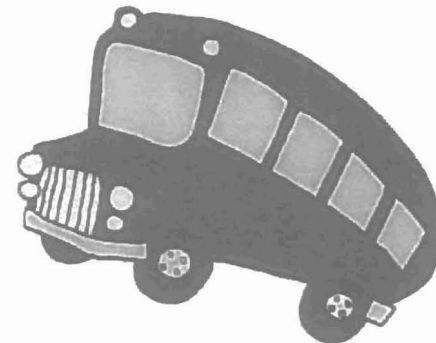

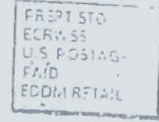
